### **IDF World Dairy Summit 2017**

Over 1,000 representatives from the global dairy sector participated in the recent World Dairy Summit in Belfast. The theme of the Summit was "Making a Difference with Dairy" and it examined the impact a vibrant, efficient and sustainable dairy industry, with nutrient rich and innovative dairy products, can have on the health of current and future generations, animal health, dairy science and technology, the environment and much more.

The event included several high profile sessions, including the World Political and Agricultural Leaders' Forum and the World Dairy Leaders' Forum, and featured ten conferences focusing on dairy policy and economics; nutrition and health; marketing; food safety; animal health and welfare; dairy science and technology; sustainability; farm management; antimicrobial resistance and emerging topics, as well as a series of technical tours showcasing the UK industry's state-of-the-art infrastructures.
